This is pursued by collaborating with the leaders in Family Support to better understand the effects of deployment; by frequent analysis to ensure we are meeting current needs; by the delivery of exceptional programs; and by educating and involving the civilian population in support of these elite warriors.

OUR SCOPE of SERVICE

1.FAMILIES

Third Location Decompression (TLD) seminars provide the spouse tools to prepare for their service member's return from deployment.



Sisterhood meetings foster community and are opportunities for NSW spouses to connect and discuss topics of shared concern.

Our partnership with **SEALKIDS** provides direct educational diagnostic testing services to address the complexities of a NSW child on the autism spectrum, with special needs, tutoring or struggling with behavioral/emotional difficulties.

Yearly Family Readiness Group (FRG) grants are used to increase family unity, provide educational activities and empower peer support and close interaction between NSW families.

Emergency Assistance and immediate access to resources is a critical safety net for a wide assortment of activities and issues that arise for Naval Special Warfare families on short notice.

2.WARRIORS

Injury and Emergency Assistance is provided to the service member for issues that arise unexpectedly.

Gold Star Family Support includes, but is not limited to, Command memorial service/reception expenses for a fallen service member, family trips to internment sites, holiday gatherings and events for families, assistance with private family foundations and the establishment of memorials.



Surviving Children and Spouse Bereavement Programs are in the form of an annual summer camp for ages 5-18 years old and long weekend academies for Gold Star teens, young adults and surviving spouses.

We host airfare, lodging and meals for NSW Gold Star families annually for the wreath laying ceremonies in conjunction with **Wreaths Across America** in Arlington and San Diego.
